

Fly Tying Meeting Wednesday 26 February at 7.15pm in Stokes Valley RSA

This month we will tie the X Caddis in three different sizes 12, 14 and 16. This dry fly is a variation of the Elk Hair Caddis and has the addition of CDC as an underwing. Watch Tim Cammisa tie the fly in the video clip. <https://youtu.be/NGpDWm7pz7U>



Most of us will be rusty after the Xmas break so this is a fairly easy fly to make.

The fly is very suitable as an indicator fly for a dry dropper rig due to its very good buoyancy and of course can be fished solo during a Caddis hatch.

The Bound Shield Challenge this month is to tie a dry fly which has rubber legs in the dressing. We are looking for a fly that should be irresistible to feeding trout. You could make a large foam monstrosity or a more realistic smaller fly or beetle, Cicada or spider.

Bring your leggy fly to the February meeting for judging.
