#### Advance Notice - June AGM - Notices of Motion and Remits



Fly of the month – Copper John



The Copper John is a handy nymph to have in the fly box. It doesn't look very like a natural fly but is a proven fish catcher. Because it is composed mainly of wire it sinks really fast and so it can reach fish that may be lying deep in fast water or where a short drift is necessary because of snags in the river. This fly is best tied in smaller sizes and can be used very effectively in combination with an unweighted, 'bobbing' fly tied off the hook in truck and trailer fashion.

## **Last Supper for Ian Lawson**


